UNIVERSITY COVID-19 MITIGATION GUIDELINES  
FOR THE CONTRACTOR COMMUNITY  
Concerning Face Coverings  
Dated: June 24, 2021

To all Construction Managers, General Contractors and Trade Contractors who are performing work on University property:

In accordance with the recent COVID-19 update from Center for Disease Control and Governor Lamont's Executive Order update issued May 18, 2021, new guidance has been provided on the wearing of face coverings in the State of Connecticut. The University of Connecticut is reviewing these modifications and will be issuing comprehensive guidance later this summer. In the interim and until notified otherwise, the following policy regarding face coverings on worksites and on campus shall apply to capital projects:

- Workers who are conducting work outside of buildings or on the exterior of buildings are not required to wear face coverings.
- Workers performing work inside a building or in an enclosed space while on campus shall wear a face covering while within the building or enclosed space, except if specifically prohibited by OSHA.
